<p>1. Authority 51 P.S. Sec. 20221 et seq 10 U.S.C. Sec. 503 20 U.S.C. Sec. 7908</p>	<p>In accordance with law, the Joint Operating Committee shall permit disclosure of required student information about secondary students to representatives of postsecondary institutions and to representatives of the armed forces of the United States.</p> <p>Equitable access to secondary students shall be granted to postsecondary education representatives, military recruiters and prospective employers.</p>
<p>2. Guidelines</p>	<p>Postsecondary institutions and military recruiters shall have access to secondary students' names, addresses and telephone numbers, unless the student or parent/guardian requests that such information not be released without prior written parental consent.</p> <p>As the Upper Bucks County Area Vocational Technical School is a shared-time career and technical school working as an extension of the participating school districts, this process will be handled through these districts. Such student information will be distributed through the participating districts.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Administrative Director shall determine under what conditions and when access to secondary students will be provided to representatives of postsecondary institutions, military recruiters and prospective employers.</p> <p>The Administrative Director reserves the right to deny access to students when such access will materially and substantially interfere with the proper and orderly operation of the school.</p>
