Dr. Blessington was raised in a small town outside of Rochester, New York but came to Pennsylvania to earn his Bachelor's Degree in Chemistry from Haverford College. Thereafter, he pursued his interest in science as a research specialist at the University of Pennsylvania where he published his findings on pediatric Leukemia.

Dr. Blessington then attended Temple University's Kornberg School of Dentistry. There he showed his commitment to treating the underserved through many outreach programs. With aid from a local Rotary Club, he spearheaded a weeklong mission trip to a rural area in the Dominican Republic where he and his colleagues provided free dental care to a community desperately in need.
