125. ADULTS ENROLLED IN SECONDARY PROGRAMS	
1. Purpose	It is the philosophy of the Upper Bucks County Technical School to provide educational offerings, opportunities and programs not just to secondary students but to afford the same opportunity to adults as well. With the changing society and its technologies, every opportunity to provide programs and services to allow communities to grow and prosper with change shall be extended. Enrolling adults in secondary career and technical programs will enhance the quality and extent of the program.
2. Authority SC 502, 1801, 1805, 1841, 1850.1 Title 22 Sec. 4.3	The Joint Operating Committee shall establish a program for adults participating in the secondary career and technical program(s) of the school.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	The guidelines and procedures for adults enrolled in secondary programs shall be developed and revised by the Adult Education Coordinator and the Executive Director and/or designee.
4. Guidelines	Program availability shall be based on the program's (shop's) quotas as per Article 126 Procedure and Guideline. Preference will be given to secondary students within participating school districts, prior to enrollment of any adult.
