FITNESS CENTER</p> <p>The Upper Bucks County Technical School (UBCTS) Fitness Center was built for the specific purpose of serving the needs of our Wellness and Law Enforcement classes. Qualified employees may utilize the Fitness Center as well as those under specific circumstances as approved by the Executive Director. For this reason, the following rules are provided.</p> <p><u>Administration</u></p> <p>The administration of the UBCTS Fitness Center is under the direction of the Health/Wellness teacher and the Supervisor of Student Services.</p> <p><u>Instructional Use</u></p> <p>Certified physical education teachers will be present at all times when the Fitness Center is to be used by the students. All physical education teachers must receive training on the use of all Fitness Center equipment before instructing students. Students will be permitted to use the Fitness Center only when under the supervision of a physical education teacher or qualified staff member.</p> <p><u>General Public Use</u></p> <p>The general public will not be permitted to use the Fitness Center.</p> <p><u>Miscellaneous Provisions</u></p> <p>All UBCTS employees who wish to use the Fitness Center are required to complete a waiver of liability for Fitness Center use. Those individuals with medical and health conditions should consult a physician before starting any exercise program. All forms are to be submitted to the Supervisor of Student Services.</p> <p>Employees may use the Fitness Center during non-contractual time. Employees may not use the Fitness Center when students are in the building.</p>
