<p>223. USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES</p>	
<p>1. Purpose</p>	<p>Due to a lack of adequate parking facilities and a method of controlling student driving to/from the career and technical school, all registered students must ride district-owned/leased vehicles for transportation purposes to and from the Upper Bucks County Area Vocational Technical School during normal school days and hours. Students are also not permitted to walk to/from the career and technical school.</p>
<p>2. Authority</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee, in conjunction with the sending schools, shall provide safe transportation in the form of owned or leased buses for transport of students between the sending school and the career and technical school.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee prohibits the use of mini-bikes, motorcycles or skateboards on school property.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee shall not be responsible for motor vehicles that are lost, stolen, or damaged.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Administrative Director and/or designee may grant exceptions to this policy, but only on a short-term or temporary basis. Driving is a special privilege given on a merit basis, with First Honors students receiving first consideration.</p>
