<p>1. Purpose</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee acknowledges the importance of offering students the opportunity to participate in self government within the school.</p> <p>The purpose of student government shall be to develop student leadership, provide a learning experience in democratic decision-making, and offer another avenue toward the realization of goals.</p>
<p>2. Authority SC 511, 1850.1</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee establishes that students shall have the right to organize, conduct meetings, elect officers and representatives, and petition the Joint Operating Committee.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee will recognize an Executive Council comprised of officers of each Career and Technical Student Organization (CTSO) as the official voice of the student body.</p>
<p>SC 511</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee shall appoint a qualified member of the faculty to serve as an advisor for CTSO activities.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Administrative Director or designee shall establish rules and regulations to implement this policy which:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Invite the participation of students in their formulation. 2. Assure that all students have equal access to the student government and an equal opportunity to vote and hold office. 3. Require fiscal accountability and adherence to Joint Operating Committee policy for all financial aspects of student government activity. <p>All approved career and technical student organizations shall adhere to the guidelines as established by their national or state charters. Those procedures and guidelines shall be on file with the office of the Administrative Director.</p>
