SUPER-Articulation Agreement with Career and Technical High Schools, Bucks County Community College, and Bloomsburg University

While in high school at a CTC:


- Advanced on NOCTI & earn at least 1 industry credential
 20 Bucks credits
- At least 200 Co-op hours
 - = 3 credits

No cost to CTC student

Take up to 4 Bucks courses (3 credits each) taught at a CTC



Graduate high school having earned up to <u>35</u> college credits at Bucks!



- Enroll at Bucks
- Complete remaining 26-38 credits in Technical Entrepreneurship degree program



College credits earned in high school + Bucks credits taken after high school =

Associate's Degree in Technical Entrepreneurship!

Transfer at least 60 credits into Bloomsburg University!



- Transfer 60-75 college credits to Bloomsburg University
- Take 45-60 credits through BU either on-site, online, or blended



Associate's Degree + Bloomsburg = 120 college credits
